



## FREE SEMINAR Do we all belong? Prepare your students for 21st century global citizenship

The Global Learning Centre (GLC) is delivering a special seminar series *Do we all belong?* to help Queensland teachers, curriculum leaders and support staff develop globally aware students who are critically literate, socially connected and ethically responsible.

Delivered in five regional and remote locations between February and March 2018, the seminar series is part of the GLC's broader professional learning program *Global Citizenship Education: A passport to social cohesion* and is fully funded for Queensland educators working in early childhood centres, schools and TAFE.

By attending the seminar, you will learn about:

- discriminatory trends that pose challenges to social cohesion
- examples of these challenges in local contexts
- evidence-based strategies aligned with the Early Years Learning Framework and P-10 Australian Curriculum to develop your students as critically aware global citizens.

Each seminar will involve a presentation and interactive workshop, so you can practise the strategies you learn with your peers. You'll also receive a list of resources to help you in your own classroom, and hear firsthand how other teachers are using the strategies with their students.

Each seminar will be run as a full-day session (9.00am–3.00pm) or, for those who need more flexibility, a twilight session (4.00pm–5.30pm) will also be available (this will be an abridged version of the full-day session). Participants can receive up to 4.5 hours of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and a completion certificate.
