FREE ONLINE TRAINING FOR QUEENSLAND TEACHERS

Want to help your students become critically engaged global citizens?

Throughout Term 2, 2018, the Global Learning Centre (GLC) will be running two online training programs that will help you develop globally aware students who are critically literate, socially connected and ethically responsible. Both programs are free for Queensland teachers working in early childhood centres, schools and TAFE.

PROGRAM 1: Global Citizenship Education: A passport to social cohesion online course

Offering strategies, resources and real-life examples, this course is delivered in six modules that are available any time between 30 April and 11 June 2018, so you can complete them at a time that suits you.

By completing this course, you'll learn about:

- trends in Australia's changing population and the implications for educators
- current social and cultural challenges and how these affect teaching and learning
- the latest innovations in Global Citizenship Education (GCE) and examples of best-practice taking place across Queensland
- strategies and resources to help you introduce GCE into your own classroom.

You can also receive up to six hours of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and a completion certificate (you must complete at least two modules to receive a certificate).
